

PROFESSIONAL TEAMS' TESTING AT MSV VENUES – HOW WE ARE KEEPING CUSTOMERS SAFE

We have implemented a range of procedures at our venues to minimise the need for contact between people when attending test days for professional teams. These are intended to be both practical and more convenient for customers, whilst providing reassurance that we're doing everything we can to keep you safe.

REGISTRATION

- All pre-event registration has been moved online, in advance. This new check-in system is mandatory and will involve completing an indemnity form electronically
- On arrival, participants will only be required to collect and apply their own wristband. You must observe 2 metre social distancing rules and there will be a queuing system in place to support this
- A member of staff will be present in the wristband collection area, behind a Perspex safety screen, to visually check licences and deal with any issues and queries
- · Hand sanitiser will be widely available

FOOD AND DRINK

- Our restaurants will be offering a takeaway service with a limited hot food menu and a number of additional safety measures in place
- · All customers are welcome to bring their own food and drink to the circuit
- · All members of catering staff will be wearing appropriate PPE

GARAGES AND PADDOCK AREAS

- On test days for professional teams, access will be restricted to two cars and four people per single garage
- Garages will remain fully open at all times (to the front and rear)

ADDITIONAL POINTS

- · Only professional teams may attend a test or track day. No-one else, including spectating friends or family members, will be permitted
- Any in-car instruction to require each of driver and instructor to have minimum of either full face helmet (visor closed) or open face helmet with face covering
- · Access to Race Control will be restricted to essential staff only
- Be advised that circuit management retain the right to pause or stop track activities if health and safety protocols (COVID-19 related or otherwise) are consistently breached
- · Participants will be required to wear face coverings when inside venue buildings. Signage will be in place to support this

OVERNIGHT STAYS

· No overnight stays will be permitted on site

TEAMS' RESPONSIBILITIES

Professional testing is a work activity and teams are required to ensure that their activities onsite are covid-secure and
risk assessed accordingly

IMPORTANT: You <u>must not</u> attend an activity if you have any symptoms of Covid-19, or you are required to self-isolate under Government guidelines. Please notify your event organiser as soon as possible to discuss re-booking arrangements.
